At the end of 2021 my puppy moved in with me:.



I named her Flocke and the first few weeks were really exhausting. I tried different bags for walking her. I then attached the poop bags with carabiners. Then I also attached a small treat bag with a carabiner.... I have to take my keys, cell phone, cigarettes, etc. with me when I leave the house. I spent 5 months looking for a good dog walking bag on all platforms and in shops and couldn't find one. Then I thought to myself, you just have to design something yourself. No sooner said than done. My SilkeN dog has 3 large pockets with an extra sewn-in zipper pocket for a small wallet or just some small change. The large pocket holds: Cell phone, cigarettes, keys, lip gloss, treat sticks for on the go and much more. A small toy, e.g. a ball, fits in the front pocket. The small front pockets have space for 2 types of treats - dog owners know why!

On one side there is space for the poop bags, i.e. the roll with plastic bags for the dog excrement. On the other side there are 2 D-rings for things to hook on, e.g. water container, dog whistle, the leash when it is running free ...

Last but not least, there is a carrying strap so that you can strap the bag around your waist. If you want to wear it cross-body, you can click a strap into the D-rings (one on each side) and have a customized bag.
