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History

COST 358 PQN

- Start: Thesis, ICTCT pedestrians → COST action + WALK21
- Lead RM + 4 WG leaders (Monterde, Risser, Sauter; Walker)
- 70 researchers from 19 EU Countries, in 4 WG's + Measuring Walking
- Reports delivered November 2010 www.walkeurope.org
- Presented at WALK21 2010 in The Hague

OECD/ITF Pedestrians

- Program: pedestrian safety
- Lead Thanos Vlastos, Véronique Feypell
- 34 participants from 19 countries + 3 International Organisations
- Summary presented at Walk21 2010, published report in 2011

Context

Increased urgency:

- Road safety issue: pedestrians do not follow general trends
- Ageing of the population: more people affected; mobility and accessibility issue
