We also enjoyed the advantages of Switzerland: snow, cheese, chocolate and sausage. But what set us the most was the encounters with you. Your interest in the work among the Indigenous, your support in prayer and financially, and that you have welcomed us so warmly. Thank you - Muchas gracias.

So we returned with a heavy heart, but very motivated back into the jungle of Peru. The team gave us a warm welcome and for Beat began an intensive working time. As coordinator of the Bible school, he is responsible for the trips of the students.

This must be imagined. There were about 40 students who had registered. First we contact them and confirm that they are accepted. We also try to discuss the trip with them and to prepare a itinerary for them to arrive on the opening day at

the Missions station Cashibo on the 19th of March. Not infrequently these brothers in faith leave their river for the first time in their lives and travel out into the great wide world. Accordingly, it is very important for them to be accessible to them during this time.

During their travels, they often report in confusion or when they need money. So the phone rang for two three weeks at all times of the day and night.

Some students were unfortunately not available and so did not even start the trip. Other students have embarked on the journey, but halfway the courage has left them, and they have traveled back to their village. This is often the case at the point, where they should change from river to road.

We were grateful to welcome 30 students and their families to the opening ceremony. More than half of them have traveled for more than 1 week. Their journey was made more difficult by landslides on the roads, which they usually crossed on foot.

Now we are happy to be with the students on the track. The motto for this year is from Ezekiel 36:26 I will give you another heart and a new spirit. I take the petrified heart from your breast and give you a living heart.

It was wonderful, the new church was finished at the opening ceremony. A small highlight: -Instead of the old rim, which served as a church bell, we now have a beautiful church bell from Switzerland. On the church bell is the engraved from 1, Corinthians 13;13 Faith, hope and love. but the greatest of these is love. At this point, a great Thanks you for all donations with the inscription Church.

Finally: Our children actually visit a jungle school. This was on the first day of school back in Cashibo in Elischa's desk. A boa - a snake.

A fate for Jose Alejandro

Beside a lot encouraging, there are also difficult times in our work. So you can still remember our Newsletter from September 2015. We have presented our brother Jose Alejandro. He lives near the Ecuadorian border. A missionary traveled to his area in the last few weeks to support the tribal Bible school. This brother wanted to pick up the missionary with his family and other passengers, in a neighboring village with his boat. Through the great waters, the boat capsized, and Jose lost two of his children. Additionally he lost the boat with the small engine. When the missionary arrived the next day in the village, she had to bury the two young lives and other victims. This was a difficult test for everyone. Later, brother Jose took the still wet Bible in his hand and found a envelop with money that he wanted to give the missionary for the tribal Bible school. She refused first, but the brother insisted that he had promised this to God. Such a faith embarrasses us. We are astonished at these faith heroes, who write stories of the Salvation, somewhere in the jungle of Peru. They are very grateful if you think of them in your prayers.
